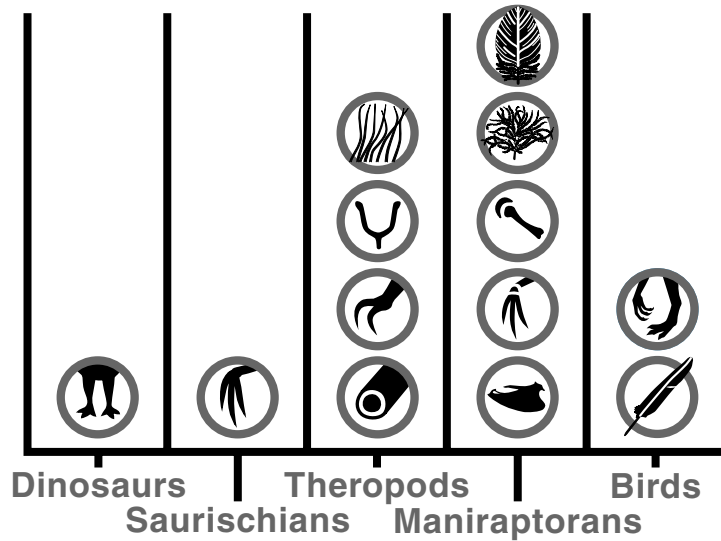


Features Table

Here we have collected all of the data represented in the three cladograms into a single table—the skeletal features, the types of feathers, and the features important in form and function. Each column contains the features that first appeared in that particular group of animals. Below the table is a key for each of the features icons.
